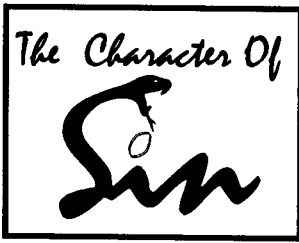

5 Sin Is Rebellion

For the last three lessons we have been studying the words for sin in Exodus 34:7. Thus far we have looked at two of these words.

- "Sin" (Hebrew: *hatta't*) – means "missing the mark"
- "Iniquity" (Hebrew: *'avon*) – means "crookedness or perversion (twisting)"

In this lesson we will study the third word for sin in Exodus 34:7:

- "Transgression" (Hebrew: *pesa'* pronounced *peh'-shah*) – means "to revolt or rebel"

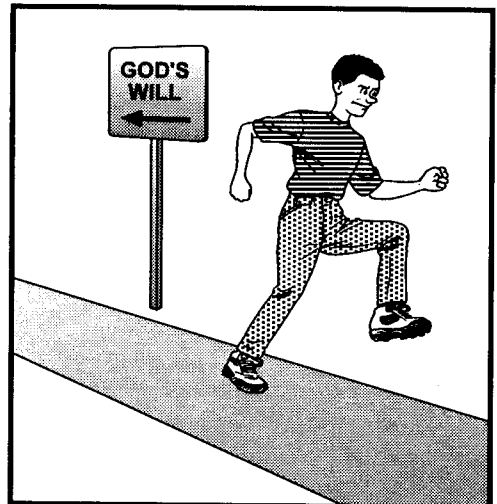

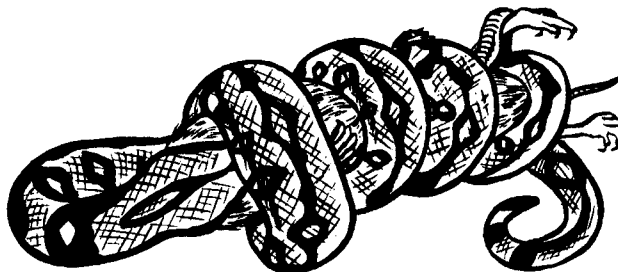

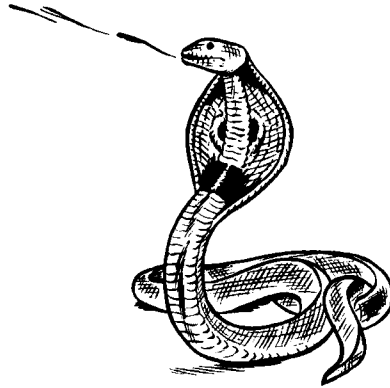
